- A. Almond Farm Update Lane Parker
 - a. Lane Parker from Almond Industries addressed the Board and gave an update of the status of the Almond Farm. This almond farm is a joint project between the Salida Union School District, Almond Board of California and the University of California, Davis. He stated that our almond production has increased from last year. This year, our trees yielded 1,200 pounds per acre in their 4th leaf. This translates into 47,494 pounds of almonds. The income generated from this crop will help to sustain the farm through the coming year. He discussed that while labor prices are rising, the bee prices have stabilized and the fertilizer costs have gone down. Big Valley Grace High School FFA, Almond Board Leadership and a group from France visited the farm to study the project. Lane suggested that we have Roger Duncan come and give a report on the production of the variety trees.
- B. General Obligation Bond Alternatives Jeff Small, Capital Public Finance Group
 - a. Jeff Small from Capital Finance Group addressed the Board regarding the General Obligation Bond process. He gave a detailed presentation on how Capital Finance Group could assist the District in planning for a GO Bond Measure.
