I. Welcome and Introductions

Superintendent Tosh welcomed the committee and thanked them for their willingness to serve. Each committee member introduced themselves and their connection with the Salida community.

Meredith Johnson introduced herself to the committee and shared a presentation on the roles and responsibilities of the Oversight Committee. She explained that the Committee's purpose is to inform the public concerning the expenditure of bond revenues, review and report on the expenditure of taxpayers' money for school construction and to issue regular reports, at least once a year, on the results of the activities. She explained that the Committee does not determine how bond funds may be spent, but, acts in an advisory capacity to the District School Board of Trustees.

IV. Election of Chair and Vice Chair

A motion was made by Joe Rizotto to nominate Dennis Thompson as Chairman of the Oversight Committee. All Members were in favor. Dennis Thompson will be Chairman of the COC.

A motion was made by Lana Moore to nominate Joe Rizotto as Vice Chair of the Oversight Committee. All Members were in favor. Joe Rizotto will serve as the Vice Chairman of the COC.

V. Establish Dates and Format of Meetings

The COC determined that Wednesday's are best for all. The Committee will meet quarterly with the next meeting taking place on Wednesday, July 21, 2021 at 3:00 P.M. in the District Boardroom.

VI. Series A Bond Sale

Dale Scott explained that the Series A Bond is a General Obligation Bond. This Bond is a constitutionally authorized debt or obligation, is voter approved, secured by a pledge of property taxes, and subject to the constraints in Education Code on borrowing. Bonds are repaid through property taxes.
